**General Rules**

- Pioneer Showdown Market Animal & Heifer show is an open show.
- Out of state animals must have vet issued health certificates meeting the State of WI requirements. It will be the discretion of the UWP B&B club to ask for vet inspection of animals that are questionable.
- Electrical power is limited; the use of generators is strongly encouraged - generators are NOT permitted in the barn.
- The UWP Block & Bridle Club is not liable for any accidents or losses.
- All entries are due by midnight on Thursday, April 23rd and are non-refundable. (Late entries are accepted but with a Late Fee)
- All tattoos must be legible & match registration papers.
- Breeds without 3 entries will be shown in the AOB class.
- All payouts will be prorated based on the number of entries.
- Barns will be for chutes ONLY. Stalling must take place on trailers.
- Individuals are asked to stall & park in designated areas ONLY. If you park or stall outside of designated areas, you will be asked to move.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up your own area. NO GARBAGE (plastic, cans, etc.) should be left in the bedding. This includes tie outs & trailer areas. Garbage bags will be provided as needed.
- The rules for Minnesota cattle have changed-TB testing is still required, but no import permit. See [DATCP Home Cattle and Bison Import Requirements - All States Except TX and MI](#) for ALL health rules.
- ANIMALS VIOLATING ANY WI DATCP RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS.
- We respect and honor the International Show Ring Code of Ethics. Direct criticism or interference with the judge, show management, other exhibitors, breed representatives, or show officials before, during or after the competitive events is prohibited.

**Heifer Rules**

- Heifers show by breed & age. ALL MUST be checked in by 7 am Saturday, April 25th.
- Commercial heifers will be shown by weight. Exhibitors will need to DECLARE their weight with the cards at the registration table no later than 5:00 pm on Friday, April 24th.
- Registration papers are required for breed heifers. Percentage heifers require papers to allow for designation to additional classes if appropriate.
- Heifers must be born after Sept 1, 2024.
- Three (3) head minimum for a breed class, otherwise shown in AOB.
- Single entry classes will enter the ring for division champion only. Each single entry will receive their class premium. Single entries MUST be ready at the beginning of the division; we will NOT hold the show.

**Market Animal Rules**

- Steers show by breed and weight. Exhibitors will need to DECLARE their weight with the cards at the registration table no later than 7:30 am on Saturday, April 25th.
- Market animals must be born after Jan 1, 2025.
- All steers and market heifers must be checked in by 7:30 am on Saturday the 25th.
- Three (3) head minimum for a breed class, otherwise shown in AOB.
- Market Heifers show by weight following the XB steer division. Exhibitors will need to DECLARE their weight with the cards at the registration table no later than 7:30 am on Saturday, April 25th.
- Single entry classes will enter the ring for division champion only. Each single entry will receive their class premium. Single entries MUST be ready at the beginning of the division, we will NOT hold the show.
