General Rules

- Pioneer Showdown Lamb show is an open jackpot show for any individual 21 and under as of January 1, 2026.
- All entries must be made through the Showman app.
- All trailers WILL BE STOPPED at the gate for health paper review.
- **PLEASE REVIEW HEALTH PAPER REQUIREMENTS BELOW!**
- **All out of state lambs must have health papers and be individually identified on the health certificates.**
- **All health papers must have a statement "FREE OF DISEASE".**
- **All lambs must have Scrapie Ear Tags that will be checked at registration. Lambs without tags will be denied exhibition.**
- **Any evidence of sore mouth, ringworm, foot rot, pink eye, wool fungus, or other contagious diseases in one lamb will disqualify the entire trailer and they will be asked to leave. KEEP INFECTIOUS ANIMALS HOME.**
- **ABSOLUTELY NO HARSH HANDLING OF ANIMALS ALLOWED; INCLUDES HITTING OR SMACKING!**
- Weigh-in will be from 6:30 to 9 am, no exceptions. NO DECLARED WEIGHTS
- Classes will be split by breed and weight. Breeds to include Hampshire, Dorset, Speckled, Natural, Southdown, Crossbred, White Face Commercial, Black Face Commercial. **WCLA BREED CLASSIFICATION GUIDELINES APPLIED.**
- Commercial ewes will be shown separately, broken into 2 divisions; White Face Commercial and Black Face Commercial.
- Ewes CAN NOT be shown in both shows. They must be shown in the market division OR the Commercial division.
- The first show will begin tentatively at 9:30 am. One showmanship will be held in between shows with the second show immediately following showmanship.
- Showmanship Class Breakdown: Beginner—9 and under; Junior—10-12; Intermediate—13-15; Senior—16 to 18; Collegiate—19-21
- There is no limit to the number of animals entered by 1 individual.
- Awards given for class winners and division champions will be pro-rated based on entries & at the discretion of the show officials.
- No painting allowed ring side.
- No stands allowed within the show ring barn area.
- Show Officials or WCLA executive board members reserve the right to make the final interpretation of the show rules as this is a WCLA sanctioned Show and we will be following the WCLA rules.
- Electrical power is limited; the use of generators is strongly encouraged - generators are NOT permitted in the barn.
- The UWP Block & Bridle Club is not liable for any accidents or losses.
- All payouts will be prorated based on the number of entries.
- Stalling must take place on trailers.
- Parking in designated areas ONLY. Anyone found parking outside those areas will be asked to move.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up your own area. NO GARBAGE (plastic, cans, etc.) should be left in the bedding. This includes trailer areas. Garbage bags will be provided as needed.
- ANIMALS VIOLATING ANY WI DATCP RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS.
- We respect and honor the International Show Ring Code of Ethics. Direct criticism or interference with the judge, show management, other exhibitors, breed representatives, or show officials before, during or after the competitive events is prohibited.
